

Who Is in the Settlement Agreement* Target Population?

The Settlement Agreement target population for housing includes Virginians with developmental disabilities age 18 and older who are in one the following categories:

- *Living in a training center, intermediate care facility, skilled nursing facility or group home & eligible for the Medicaid DD Waiver*
- *Receiving Medicaid DD Waiver services*
- *On a waitlist for Medicaid DD Waiver services*

* The Commonwealth of Virginia entered into a Settlement Agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice to develop a system of services that supports individuals' participation in the most integrated settings in the community. The Agreement includes the creation of housing options for eligible individuals with DD.
